Open to residents of the Debra Dynes Housing Community for tuition, books, mandatory fees and/or academic supplies (including computer equipment)

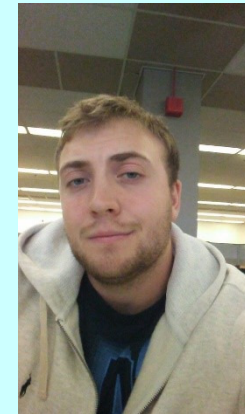
